# LEARN TRAFFIC SAFETY WITH DSAT

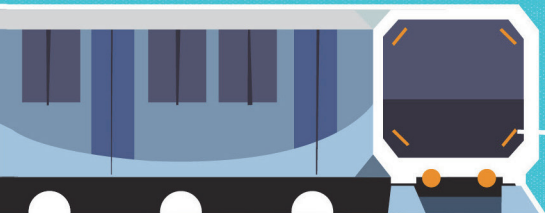
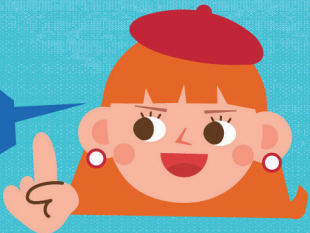


# 1 Means of transportation in Macao



What are the common means of transportation in Macao?

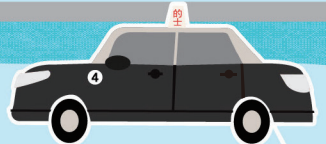

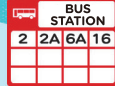

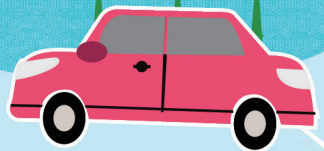

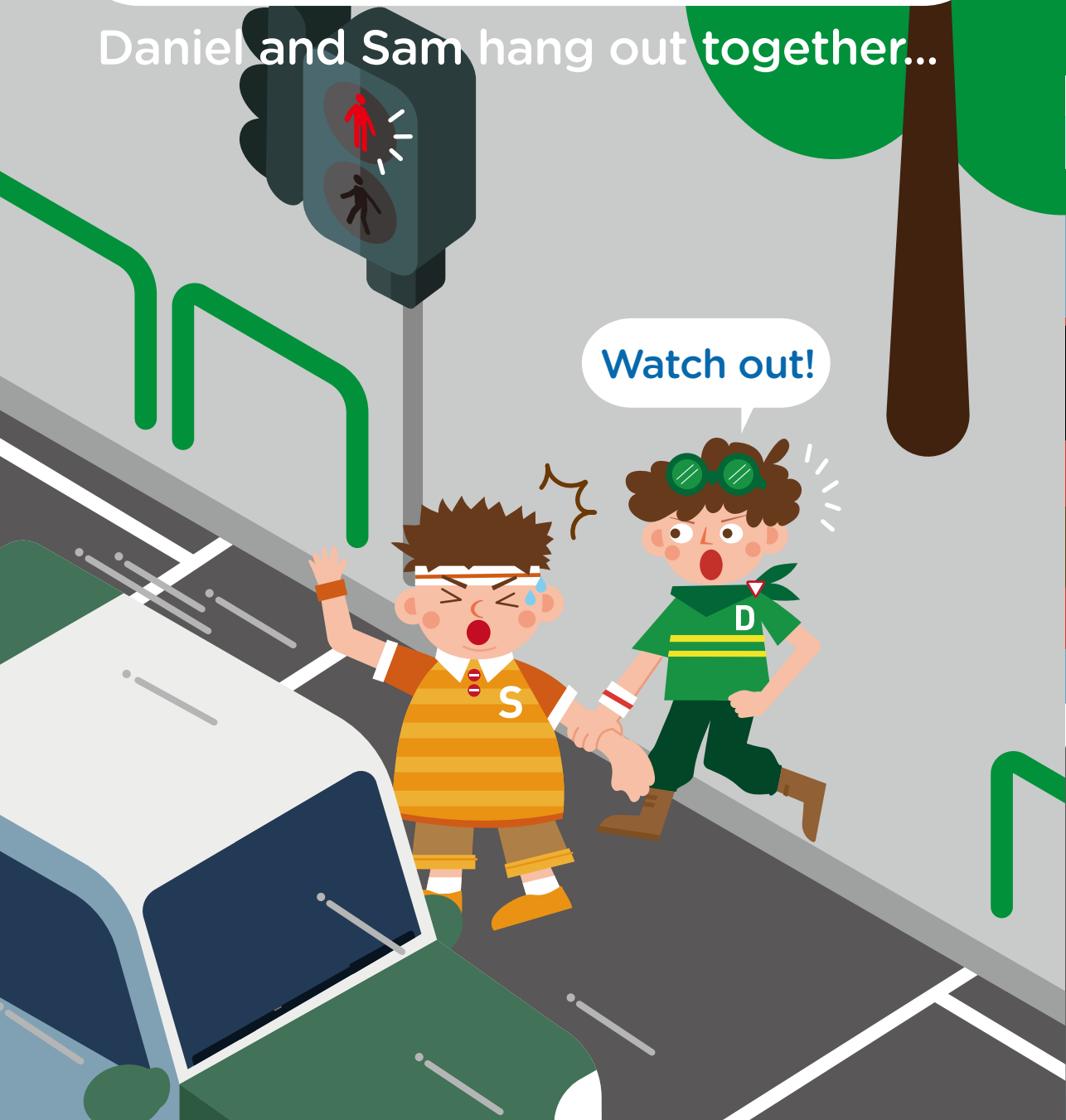

Older than **12** years old (inclusive)

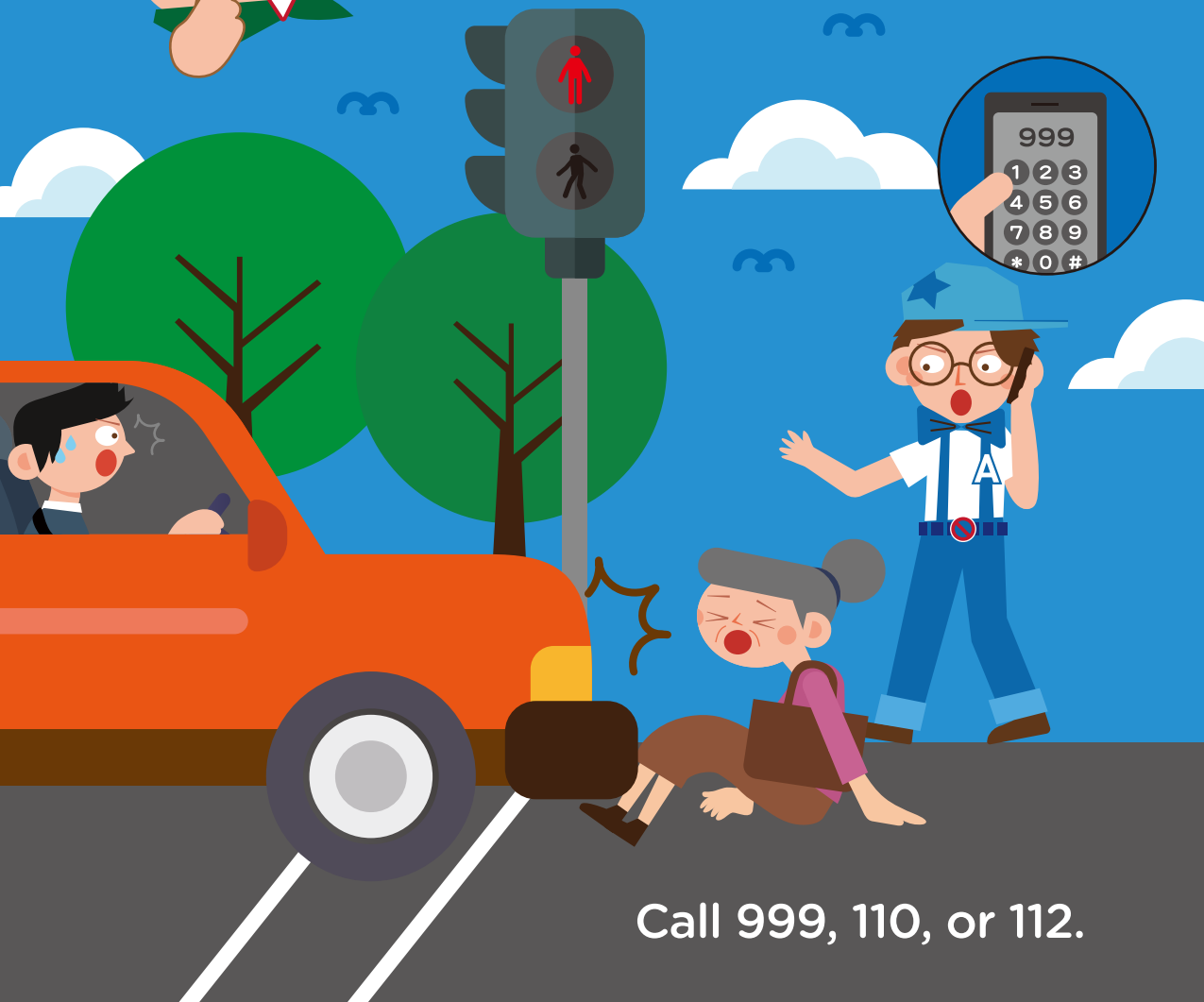


A kid older than 12 years old (inclusive) can take a front seat of a car
